Items for Discussion:

The Pioneer Days committee meeting will be put on the next agenda for the member meeting and volunteers will be recruited. We will reach out to them to see if the \$2,500 will still cover the planters and if they would still like to continue the round robin style of doing the planters.
- **Scholarship Committee** – A request for volunteers will be put out at the next meeting.
